Dear Parents and Guardians

We will be holding our annual **Open Evening** from 6pm-7.30pm on Wednesday 30 August.

The main purpose of the **Open Evening** is to provide an opportunity for Year 6 pupils and their parents/whanau from our contributing schools to visit and see our '*school in action*'. Visitors will be able to observe our students and teachers involved in a range of teaching and learning activities. Parents of students already attending Intermediate are also welcome to attend.

Students who do attend the Open Evening, with parental permission, will be dismissed from school at 12.30pm on Friday 1 September.

Students who do not attend the Open Evening will be dismissed from school at the usual time of 2.45pm on Friday 1 September.
